Later this week, Brazilian organist Cristiano Rizzotto Vidal Pessoa will perform at the St. Meinrad Archabbey Church.

The concert is set to start this Saturday, August 3rd at 3 pm central time at the church. Cristiano holds a bachelor's degree in piano performance from the Universidade Federal do Rio de Janiero, where he graduated as magna cum laude in 2010. In 2009, he was an exchange student in the United States courtesy of the Brazilian government's Ministry of Education program.

Cristiano has performed as a concert pianist in several solo recitals and as a piano accompanist in several cities and states of Brazil since 2007. He was awarded second place at the XVIII ArtLivre National Piano Competition.
